The vines in ColleMassari's Poggio Lombrone vineyard were planted in 1952, and the warm 2015 growing season accentuates the sweet fruit and round tannins that characterize sangiovese from this region. Unlike riservas from Montalcino, which borders the region to the northwest, this wine can be enjoyed immediately for its soft spiced-cherry and baked-plum flavors."
